Our current charges equate to approximately 40p/sq. m. I have carried out some investigation and found that both Wherwell and Andover charge the same. However, Wherwell incudes the supply of water but in Chilbolton we have no supply and Andover charge separately for water. Andover proposes increasing their rental by 10% next year and a similar increase would result in an additional £27 income for CPC.
