

**CHILBOLTON ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY**

1. Apologies - NONE
2. Approval of the minutes dated [17 April 2019](#). These were agreed as an accurate record of the meeting.
3. Report of Chilbolton Parish Councils activities in the last year from Parish Council Chairman ([APA21 1](#)). There were no questions or comments on this report (other than what a good report it was).
4. Report of Hampshire County Council activities in the last year from Hampshire County Councillor Andrew Gibson ([APA21 2](#), [2a](#), [3b](#)). There were no questions or comments on this report.
