SEARCH AGREEMENT

Chilbolton Parish Council being occupier of land known as West Down Nature Reserve situated south of Chilbolton village, agree that in consideration of the payment to the occupier of 50 % of the value or rewards arising from the recovery of any property or objects found by the undersigned [herein after called the licensee] over the value of £ 1,000, the licensee may enter the said land or part thereof to search for items of buried or other material, whether antique or modern.

This agreement shall continue in force until 31st December 2020. Provided that: -

- 1 The licensee shall be a current National Council for Metal Detecting (NCMD) member.
- 2. The licensee shall always observe and adhere to the Code of Conduct as set out by the NCMD.
- 3. The licensee shall strictly observe and adhere to any guidelines or special conditions and area boundaries, which may be set out by the occupier from time to time. Boundary areas are shown on the map annexed to this license.
- 4. The licensee shall record all finds to the Portable Antiquities Scheme (PAS) that fall within their remit and inform the Chilbolton Parish Council (CPC). In any case the CPC request to be informed of any find valued at more than £100 and may at their discretion ask the licensee to provide details of the find to other third parties.

Special Notes

- 1. There shall be no digging in the prohibited areas shown on the map annexed to this license which includes the large area formerly used for household waste disposal.
- 2. The licensee shall operate in accordance with the NCMD Code of Practice
- 3. The licensee should be aware that the land was in use by the military in the past and ordnance may still be present. Searching the site is at the licensee's own risk.
- 4. The license will be withdrawn if any of the rules are contravened
